Safety Guidelines

Fencing is an extremely safe sport. I've heard it said that fencing is safer than golf, and that may not be far from the truth. I've been fencing for over 24 years and have never seen a serious injury. However, that's because the people with whom I've been fencing have been conscious of safety issues. You must understand that even though we use sporting blades with a dull edge and a bated tip (turned back on itself, or flat, instead of pointed), the blades are still made of steel and can do serious harm. A blade can take out an eye or, if broken, may puncture. So here are some things that will be demanded of students in the interest of safety:

- We will stretch at the beginning of every class, after some light warm- up.
- When students are idle and have blades, the tips of the blades **MUST** be kept down.
- When fencing or engaging in drills that involve blades, students will wear the proper safety gear, including mask, glove and jacket.
- Students will comply with directives given by the instructor.
- Students will not fence or conduct drills unless directed to do so by the instructor. (Simply put, no "horseplay.")**
